## Monitoring Options for your NPDES System

Ohio Environmental Protection Agency requires your Non-Failsafe NPDES System to be monitored by a service provider for any alarms that may occur on the system.

## This requirement can be met by several options:

**Phone:** This connection can be from a local Phone Land Line connection compatible

with DSL service. It would be run from a telephone jack from your existing line

to the control panel for the system.

*Internet:* A Voice-Over-Internet-Protocol (phone service through your local cable

internet provider) is also available and would require a connection from your

modem to the control panel.

Cellular: A strong cellular signal would be required at the control panel location, and

would not be a part of your current cell phone service. This would be a stand

alone service.

All monitoring will require a yearly monitoring fee after the initial warranty period.
